

Instructions to a Weekend Renter

The address is ~~1000 Catskill~~ Road, Livingston Manor, NY ~~12441~~. Livingston Manor is exit 96 on Rt. 17. Heading west on Rt. 17 you would make a left at the bottom of the exit and head up ~~Dutchess~~ Road about 2 miles. There is a church on the corner of ~~Dutchess~~ and ~~Catskill~~ you can only make a left. My house is about 1.5 miles up on the left big white numbers on tree 341 and there is a white bathtub where the spring flows out of the mountain. People come from miles around to drink this spring water.

I will have my neighbor ~~bring~~ key ~~to the house~~. Enter around the back of the house. The Weber grill is a bit temperamental. Put the front burner on high/light and just barely crack the handle on the small propane tank attached to the grill. There are matches and lighter sticks in the top far left drawer in the kitchen. **Light** the front burner, wait ten seconds and then turn up the propane. You may need to **try this two** or three times to get it lit properly.

I put together a basket filled with tourist information in the living room. There is an article in the one of the Sullivan County Summer Magazines (multiple copies are at the house) highlighting local hiking, fishing and events in the area. You may want to get online before you leave and check out Mongaup State Park. Mongaup Park has hiking trails and a lake to swim and rent row boats/canoes. Also, the Beaverkill Covered Bridge Park is a nice day trip with BBQ grills (bring charcoal), proper restrooms and an area to swim in the brook under a turn of the century working covered bridge (this can also be found online). Google the names and the websites will give you specifics and directions.

If you hike up to the right of my house the trails take you to Mine Brook which is a beautiful hike along old logging trails. If you hike up the really steep hill to the left of the house it will bring you to an old rock quarry that was worked back in the 1800s. I haven't had a chance to check and clear the trails yet this year so you may encounter a few downed trees. I also own the meadow across the street from the house. Please feel free to walk the meadow. If you cross the meadow you will come to the Sprague Brook which is the sound you hear when sitting out on the deck.

Peck's Market is in the town of Livingston Manor (5 miles away) as well as quaint artsy and outdoorsy shops. From the house you make a right out of the driveway to the end of ~~Catskill~~ Road. Make a right onto ~~Dutchess~~ Road and go to the end (Old Rt. 17) and make a left. Make a right at the gas station and you will be heading directly into town. If you make a **right** onto Old Rt. 17 it will take you into the town of Roscoe about a 15 minute drive away up past the Fly Fishing Museum. Roscoe has nice little shops and restaurants to check out like the Courtyard for good food and drinks. The courtyard also has free WiFi. Tell Laurie, the manager/bartender, you're staying at PattiAnn's house in the Manor. Catskill Brewery on Old 17 in Livingston Manor and the Roscoe Brewery opened up recently and they both sell growlers and have a tasting room. Roscoe has a farmer's market on Sunday mornings starting at 11 am. They sell everything from local produce and flowers to crafts and artwork.

There is a metal firepit at the house off the deck. Firewood all around the place as well as in the container under the deck. The house is stocked with basic spices, condiments, soaps, shampoo/conditioner, sponges, coffee filters, paper goods and garbage bags. Towels are in the linen closet. Plenty of dishes, cups, pots pans, etc. if you decide to cook in.. I do not have cable or satellite but there are many DVDs in the entertainment center under the television in the living room and music cds under the end tables.

Please be sure to place cans/plastic/glass recyclables in the red can off the deck. Hope that you have wonderful weather for your weekend getaway.
