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Introduction

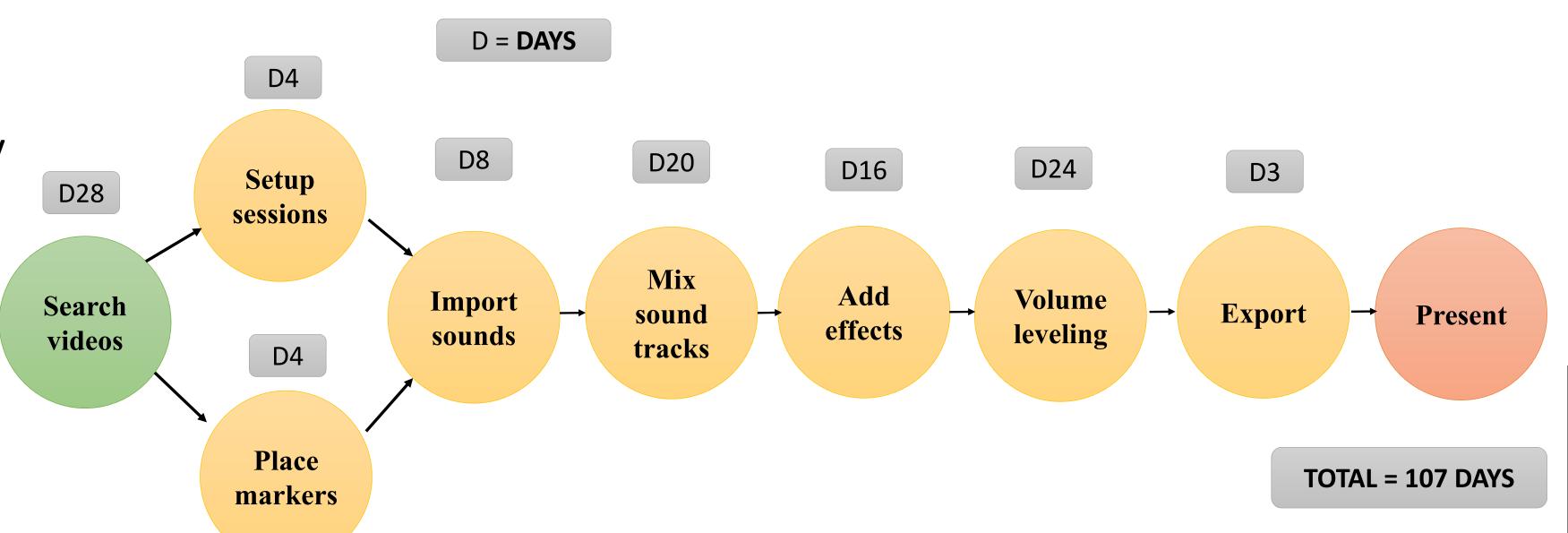

Editing and adding automated dialogue replacement (ADR), sound effects, music, and additional audio from Foley will allow me to display all the skills I've learned.

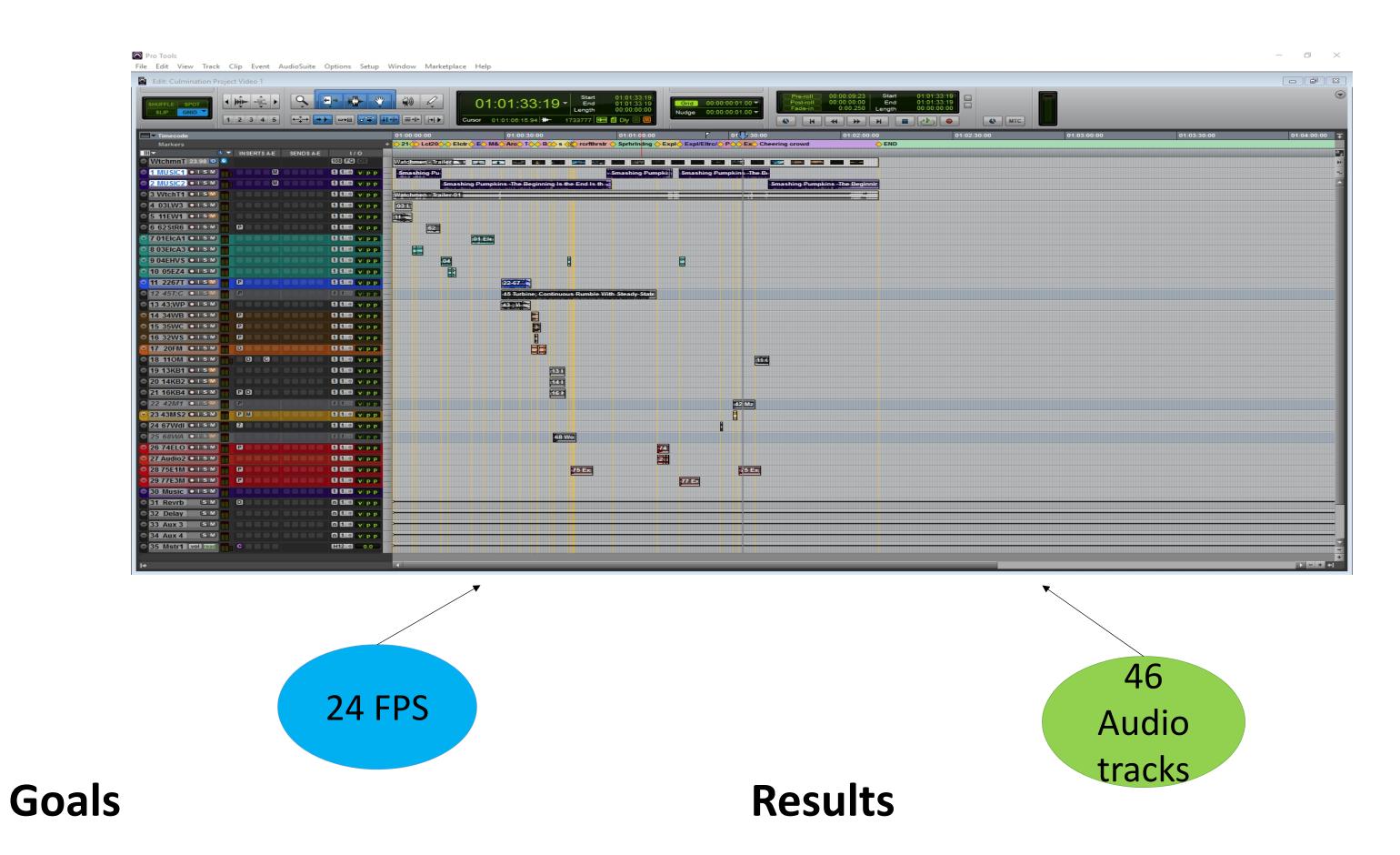
Methods

- 1. To strip the original audio and apply new sounds to the videos
- 2. To produce an accurate sound that matches the film and the frames
- 3. To make sure sounds don't distract or throw the audience off
- Audio levels are well balanced
- All sounds altered with plugin effects
