- B. GBC Maintains its headquarter in Northbrook, Chicago, USA and has significant manufacturing sites in Europe and Asia.
- C. Second Headquarter in Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire, England.
- D. Employees all locations 3600 (Actual)

- a. 1950 Creating sale and distribution networks in Europe, Mexico, Canada, Venezuela and Brazil.
- b. 1952 Expand operations in by opening another manufacturing plant in Canada.
- c. 1954 GBC established a manufacturing subsidiary in Switzerland
- d. 1960, GBC introduced the Combo binding.
- e. 1960 GBC become one of the first foreign companies to set up operations in Japan.
- f. 1962 Ventured into lamination business with purchase of Virginia laminating, a designer and manufacturer of lamination machines.
- g. 1985 GBC entered into an agreement with VeloBind, Inc., of Sunnyvale California.
- h. 2005 GBC Merged with ACCO to form the world's largest supplier of brand office products.
