
Using the Massager

• Press and hold the [0] button on the side of the massager to power the massager ON and OFF. The massager will power ON in Heat Only mode, and the [也] button will light up **RED**.

Press the [0] button to switch to Massage Only mode. The [0] button will light up **BLUE**.

• Press the [0] button again to switch to Heat + Massage mode. The [0]

button will light up GREEN. ・ Press the [①] button a 3rd time to return to Heat Only mode.



Cleaning and Maintenance

Turn the massager OFF, and let cool down. Wipe down the fabric with a damp (NOT wet) cloth or sponge. SPOT CLEAN ONLY.

Do NOT immerse the leg warmer in water.
