Using the FM Radio

For best results, set up the antenna before using the radio. Plug the antenna into the antenna port on the back of the speaker. Uncoil the cable and extend with a clear line of sight towards the sky.

Switch to FM mode. A voice will be heard, and the LED screen will display the current FM frequency.

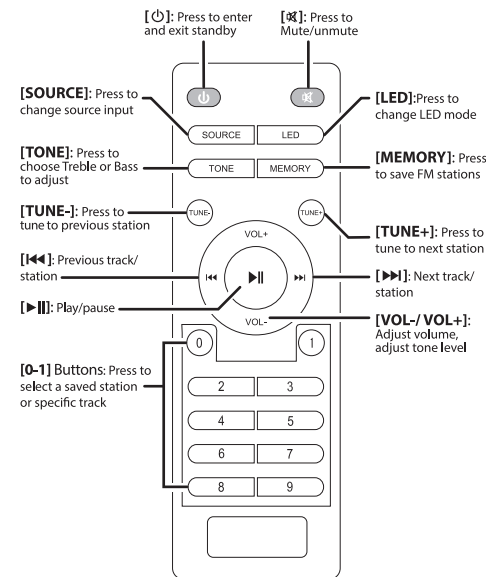
Radio functions can be controlled by the buttons on the speaker or remote control.

- Press and hold the [▶]/[SCAN] button on the speaker or the [MEMORY] button on the remote control to start automatically scanning and saving nearby available radio stations. The LED screen will show the scanning progress, and the speaker will return to the first station when finished scanning.
- To manually save channels using the remote control, press the [MEMORY] button on the remote control. The LED screen will blink. Press the [◀] and [▶] buttons to flip through stations, and press [▶] to save.
- Press the [◀]/[TUN-] and [▶]/[TUN+] buttons on the speaker or the [TUN-] and [TUN+] buttons on the remote control to skip between saved stations.
- Press and hold [◀]/[TUN-] and [▶]/[TUN+] buttons on the speaker or the [TUN-] and [TUN+] buttons on the remote control to manually flip through channels.

Using the LED Lights

Press the [LED] button to power the LED lights ON and OFF and switch between LED light modes.

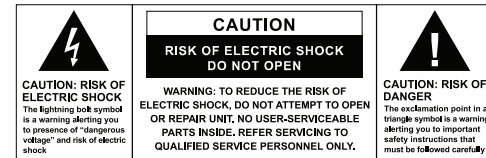

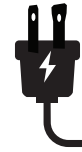

POLARIZED PLUG

If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way. 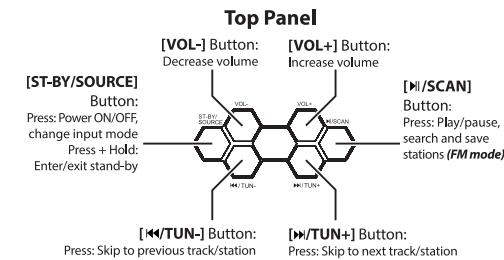

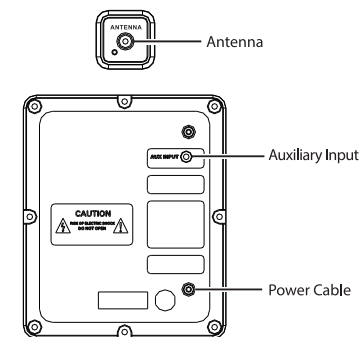
Additional Precautions and Warnings

- Always turn off and unplug when not in use or before maintenance.
- Keep away from direct sunlight, heat sources, air conditioners, and fans.
- Always keep on a stable, flat surface. Do NOT place on a carpet, bed, cushion or other non-flat, non-stable surface.
- Never move the product while in use.
- Keep the power cable clear of pathways, and do not forcefully pull or remove from the unit.
- To disconnect, grip plug and pull from wall outlet. Never pull on cord to disconnect.
- If smoke or burning smell is detected, immediately unplug the unit.
- It is recommended, if the product will not be in use for a long period of time, that the product be covered to protect it from exposure to dust.

Powering ON/ OFF

Press the **[ST-BY/SOURCE]** button to power the speaker ON or OFF. When powered ON, the speaker will enter Bluetooth® pairing mode, and will automatically re-pair to any nearby previously-paired device with Bluetooth enabled.

Switching Input Modes

Press the **[ST-BY/SOURCE]** button on the top of the speaker to switch between input modes. The LED screen on the front of the speaker will indicate the mode.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the speaker ON. The speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode, and the LED screen will display **"BI18."**
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When the list appears, select **Speaker X1** from the list of found devices.
3. Once successfully paired, you will be able to play music through the speaker.

Using the 3.5 mm Auxiliary Input

Insert one connector of the 3.5 mm auxiliary cable into the 3.5 mm auxiliary input jack on the back of the speaker. Insert the other connector into the headphone jack or audio output port of your media-playing device.

Change the input to AUX mode; the LED screen will display the word **"SPKR."**

In AUX mode, playback will be controlled by your connected device.
