You are also asked to submit student work samples that were used in the assessment. Three are required for each section: 1 good, 1 fair, and 1 poor.

Please send me both completed rubrics and student work samples by 2/19 (Wed next week) so that I can double-check their compatibilities before we submit to AIRE by the end of the next week.
