

This *neckline* was different, they inserted a short metal to make it hold the *neckline*, so it would not fall because of the *fabric*. The *dress* was made out of *jersey*. *Jersey fabric* tends to roll up, and it will not hold a *shape*, so I believe they inserted this metal for the purpose to hold the *v-neckline*. Although it was *sleeveless* this dress had more *fabric* in the shoulder area extending towards the arms giving the illusion of it to being more covered in the arm area. This *dress* was very *fitted*, and I had my doubts because I was not comfortable with my body at that moment. Before I recorded, I started working out extensively. I drank hot water with lime in the morning to achieve a toned stomach. I also used a flat iron to flatten my hair and I wore an *emerald green strap heel* to complement the *dress*.

I feel that as I continue to get invitations for events like those on a national level it will expose me to other churches. Chapter 15: I do!

I knew this day would happen ever since I met Wilkin in the singles retreat in Punta Cana. Since I went to dinner with him and it stood out for me how humble he was. What he thought was a mistake of saying to me was one of the most genuine things he said. He started out by saying simply “I come from humble beginnings. My family is very humble”. I believe it stood out to me because usually guys would want to show off, but he did not do that. Fast forward to the wedding that was going to happen in Dominican Republic, he took care of everything. He hired an event planner, and his co-workers and friends helped him with organizing the wedding. It was challenging for me since I was not the one personally going to places to set up for the wedding because I live in the United States, and he lives in the Dominican Republic, but he took care of everything like a champion.

For my wedding day, I always pictured myself with 1920’s vintage glamorous waves in my hair, and a *mermaid dress* with a *long tail*. As I was searching for my *wedding dress*, I took the risk of buying it from anlux.com. This *dress* was not designed to be a *wedding dress*, but I turned it into one. I found the *dress* and I was in love with the *design* of the *neckline*. It was like a *sweetheart neckline* but what made it different was that on the *princess side panel*, the *seam* instead of it just being *round and blending* in towards the *side seams*, it had a *pointy design* instead. I was toning my *body* for this *dress*. I ended up *tailoring* it at the *top side seams* for the *dress* to have a more *fitted fit*. I lost more weight than I intended to. The *dress* was simply white without any *designs*. I saw it as a canvas to mold it to my liking. I want it to add *embellishments* to my *dress*. I went to 38th street in Manhattan, and I bought about 7 *embellishments* and glued them to the *waist band*. The *hemline* was too long, so in efforts for me not to trip while I am walking with my dad; I *cut the hemline* about 3 inches only in the front and I *cut* to the point where the front of the *garment* connected and seamlessly blended with the *tail of the dress*. This *dress* complemented my body so well. It was *fitted*. Check. It was a *mermaid dress*. Check. And I hired a hairstylist and a makeup artist. The hairstylist to create the vintage glamorous waves took a hair wand and curled my hair and put hairspray. He slightly pushed my hair up with a tail comb to create a voluminous look. My makeup artist, I told her I wanted a look that I saw on her. The look she had on an image I liked was glamorous but natural. She put highlight which I love to use in makeup, and she put in my *decolletage* as well.
