- The most important issue we had was getting approval for our blood scenes.
 We couldn't film these right away. We had to ask for permission from John McCullough who had to send out information school safety to make it happen.






Editing

- I had to relearn some technique for editing. It wasn't much, but it did help to try to make it look better.
- We had about 337 files worth of footage.
 We didn't use most of them, but chose the ones that flow well in timeline.
- There were alot of scenes we had to cut out. Some scenes had missing shots and it didn't looked good. There were also scenes that didn't make sense and was confusing.
- The thing we did the most was using the J and L cuts. This method helps us a lot with all the mistakes we were having during post production.






Audio Mixing

- We had to fix the audio for some portion for scenes.
- Some sounded low, some sound a little high, and some sounded like it was from a different room.
- I work on these when Vishal was fixing some mistake we made on our 2nd rough cut.
