Project Description

For my culmination project, I want to produce a documentary on Academy for careers in TV and film and how studying film affected the the graduates career choices to either follow the path of working in the film industry or deciding to go another route. I went to the Academy for Careers in TV and Film for high school. My high school was based off the idea that they could have people who have worked in the industry teach teens in high school what you need to do to work in the film industry. They taught kids at a younger age in high school so that they would have a head start if they decided to work in the Tv/Film industry. My high school teaches all aspects of film and when you get into your junior and senior year you begin to focus on one specialized position in the industry that you want to do like directing, camera, lighting, sound, editing, props, production design, etc..... I also want to interview current students of the high school to get there take on how the high school might affect there future and what they want to do. I want to see if people who decided not to continue if it was based off of a personal choice or if it had something to do with the high school. If I get permission too I would also like to shoot some of the graduates who decided to continue in the film industry in action by shooting them on set and show them using the tools that my high school taught them. I will also be part of the documentary to give my insight on how my high school has affected me up to this point in my life and how it will affect my future.

Methods

For this project I will be working with a set of equipment as follows. I will be using HD professional camcorder, I will be using an omnidirectional microphone, three fluorescent soft lights, a magnus tripod and one to two SD cards. I will be using Avid to edit my film because at my time here at City Tech I have taken two Avid based classes and have become familiar with the software. Avid is also the industry standard editing software. I will be shooting sit down interviews from the perspective of over and including my shoulder, I will also be getting action shots of people filming, some may be based on the tripod and some might be handheld. I plan on asking certain professors at City Tech who know Avid well in case I get stuck or need help. Some technical challenges I might overcome are trying to use the equipment in unique and different styles then how most people might use them. This is also my first real time taking the

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equipment out to shoot on location so using the equipment the in a different location might raise some challenges as well.


