

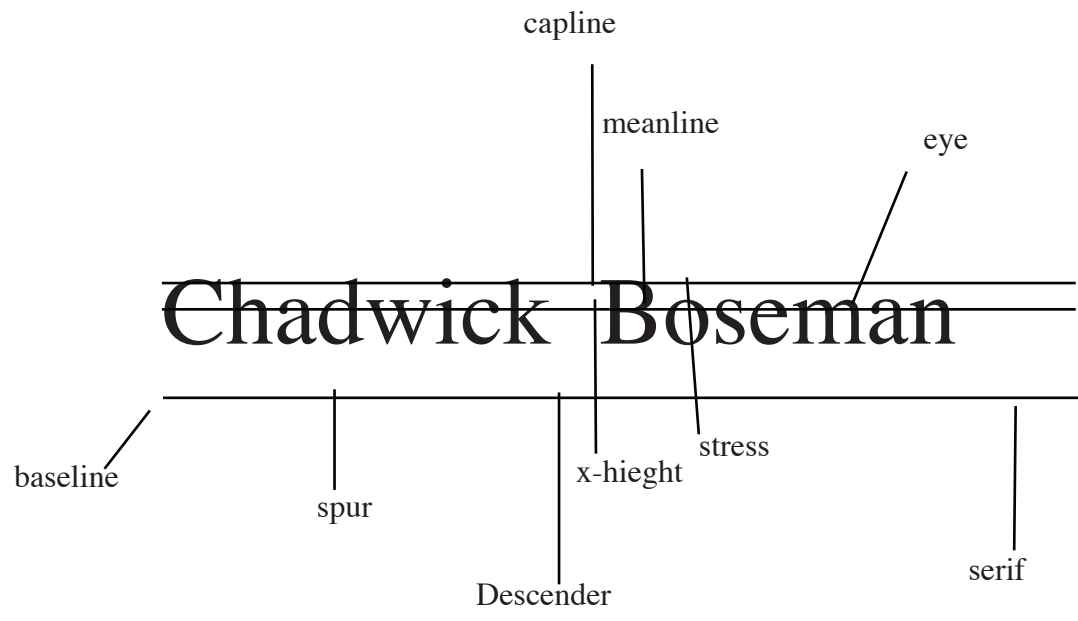

U.S. Mayors Are Taking Action on Climate Change, Survey Finds

An alliance of U.S mayors and an environmental nonprofit organization announced on Thursday survey results that indicate a majority of cities are taking action to reduce carbon pollution.

The report, unveiled at the winter meeting of the U.S. Conference of Mayors in Washington, shows that 60% of 182 cities surveyed have “launched or significantly expanded” a climate initiative or policy in the past year, and that nearly all cities surveyed have experienced at least one “climate impact” over the past five years.

Mayors from across the country – from Los Angeles to Des Moines to New Orleans – joined together for a conference session to discuss the urgency of the findings. “We are at a critical crossroads,” said St. Petersburg, Florida, Mayor Rick Kriseman. “We need all hands on deck.”

Yankees World Series Hero Dies a 90

Don Larsen, the only main in baseball history to pitch to perfect game during the World Series , died on Wednesday according to his representative, Andrew Levy. He was 90 years old. Lansen pitched on 14 MLB seasons between 1953-1966. The right handed journeyman held an 81-91 career record- including major league worst losses in 1954- with a 3.78 ERA.

Boseman acted on stage in multiple productions, winning an AUDELCO award in 2002, and he also directed and wrote plays. Part of the Hip Hop theater movement, his play-writing included Rhyme Deferred (co-writer and performer), and Hieroglyphic Graffiti. Boseman's script for Deep Azure was commissioned by the Congo Square Theatre Company in Chicago, and was nominated for a 2006 Joseph Jefferson Award for New Work. He directed a number of theater productions, and directed, wrote, and produced the short film, Blood Over a Broken Pawn in 2007, which was honored at the 2008 Hollywood Black Film Festival.

In 2003, Boseman was cast in his first television role, an episode of Third Watch. That same year, Boseman portrayed Reggie Montgomery in the daytime soap opera All My Children, but stated that he was fired after voicing concerns to producers about racist stereotypes in the script; the role was subsequently re-cast, with Boseman's future Black Panther co-star Michael B. Jordan assuming the role. His early work included episodes of the series Law & Order, CSI: NY, and ER. In 2008, he played a recurring role on the television series Lincoln Heights and appeared in his first feature film, The Express: The Ernie Davis Story, as running back Floyd Little. He landed his first regular role in the 2010 television series Persons Unknown.

Boseman's breakthrough role was in the 2013 film 42, in which he portrayed baseball pioneer and star Jackie Robinson. He had been directing an off-Broadway play in East Village when he auditioned for the role, and was considering giving up acting and pursuing directing full-time at the time. About 25 other actors had been seriously considered for the role, but director Brian Helgeland liked Boseman's bravery and cast him after he had auditioned twice. Robinson's widow, Rachel Robinson, commented that Boseman's performance was like seeing Jackie again. The same year, Boseman also starred in the independent film The Kill Hole, which was released in theaters a few weeks before 42.
