- The First episode of this series is called Brooklyn / Manhattan Bridge.



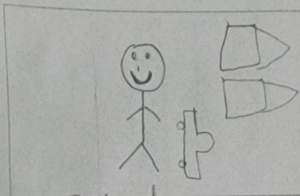
Why Brooklyn / Manhattan Bridge area?

- The name brings more attention to the video.

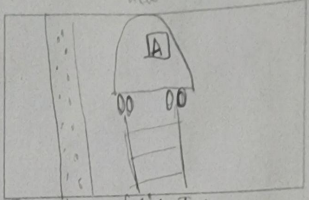

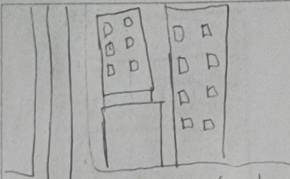

How was it recorded?

- The video was recorded on a Samsung Galaxy S22 Ultra phone.
- The sound was recorded on a Samsung Galaxy S22 phone.
- Using a slating technique of clapping before every shot, I was able to sync video and sound in post production.



Video recording details

- Video was recorded using a PRO VIDEO on my phone.
- It was recorded with ULTRA HIGH DEFINITION (UHD) at 60 FPS.
- A handheld stabilizer for phones was used to shoot steady shots.



Sound Recording Details

- Using the PRO VIDEO feature on a different Samsung, I recorded the sound
- Using a wired Lavalier Microphone I was able to record the sound





Post Production and Voice over Recording

- To edit the video I used Adobe Premiere Pro.
- The video also has voice over recording that was recording using personal gaming headphones and the Adobe voice over feature.
- Background music was also added to the video.
