



Final Type Book

Saving your files:

Save your InDesign file as:

COMD1167_LastnameFirstInitial_typebook

Then save again as a PDF:

Go to File > Export > Adobe PDF (Print)

Add finished PDF to Drive

You will need to collect all of your documents together and publish them as one single book. These books will be printed out and bound along the short left edge, where we left space for such details. They should have a clear vinyl front cover and a black vinyl back cover with spiral binding along the left side.

The list and order of pages you should have:

1. Cover Page	1 page
2. Anatomy and Letterform	1 page
3. 5 Families of Type	5 pages
4. Examples of Type Variation	6 pages
5. Alignment (Parts 1 and 2)	2 pages
6. Leading	2 pages
7. Tracking	2 pages
8. Kerning	1 pages
9. Paths	1 page
10. Legitibility (Color)	1 page
11. Hierarchy	1 Page
12. Grid	2 Pages
13. Logotype	1 Page
14. (Optional) Works Cited	1 page

- You need to go over your work and make sure the pages are consistently laid out so that the book is cohesive and clean.
- For every exercise, you should be using the type book template which is 11"x8.5" which is a landscape document.
- On each exercise, the Title should use a consistent font.
- On each exercise, the 5th column is reserved for the title and sometimes the description as cited in the directions.
- On each exercise, you use only columns 1-4 for the exercise itself.
