As a student at MIT, studying computer programming, the legendary Muriel Cooper persuaded him to follow his parallel passion for fine art and design.

When computer-aided design began to explode in the mid-1990s, Maeda was in a perfect position at the MIT Media Lab to influence and shape the form, helping typographers and page designers explore the freedom of the web.



Pay attention to detail; if a design is truly good, it can stand on it's own no matter how `simple' it is. Beauty is in every aspect of the design of course.

Subtract the obvious; for example, if you're creating a burger company logo, maybe you don't need to stamp on a burger logo there, how about adding something more meaningful.


Don't get turn up over what's simple or what the little things, like what's complex or what's simple. Feel the design as it is and add what you may. Don't think you have to fix one particular style.






BOOK COVER, ART DECO Inspired Main symbol used in his book about simplicity




