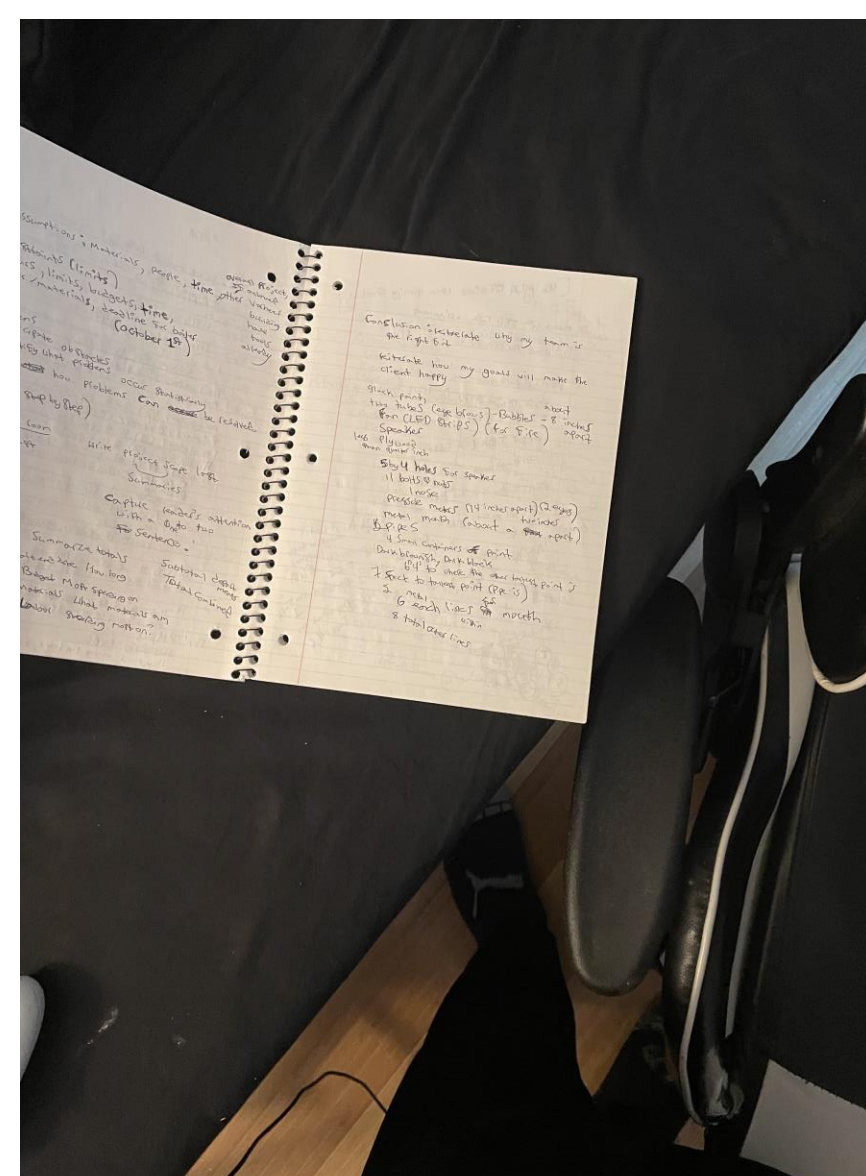
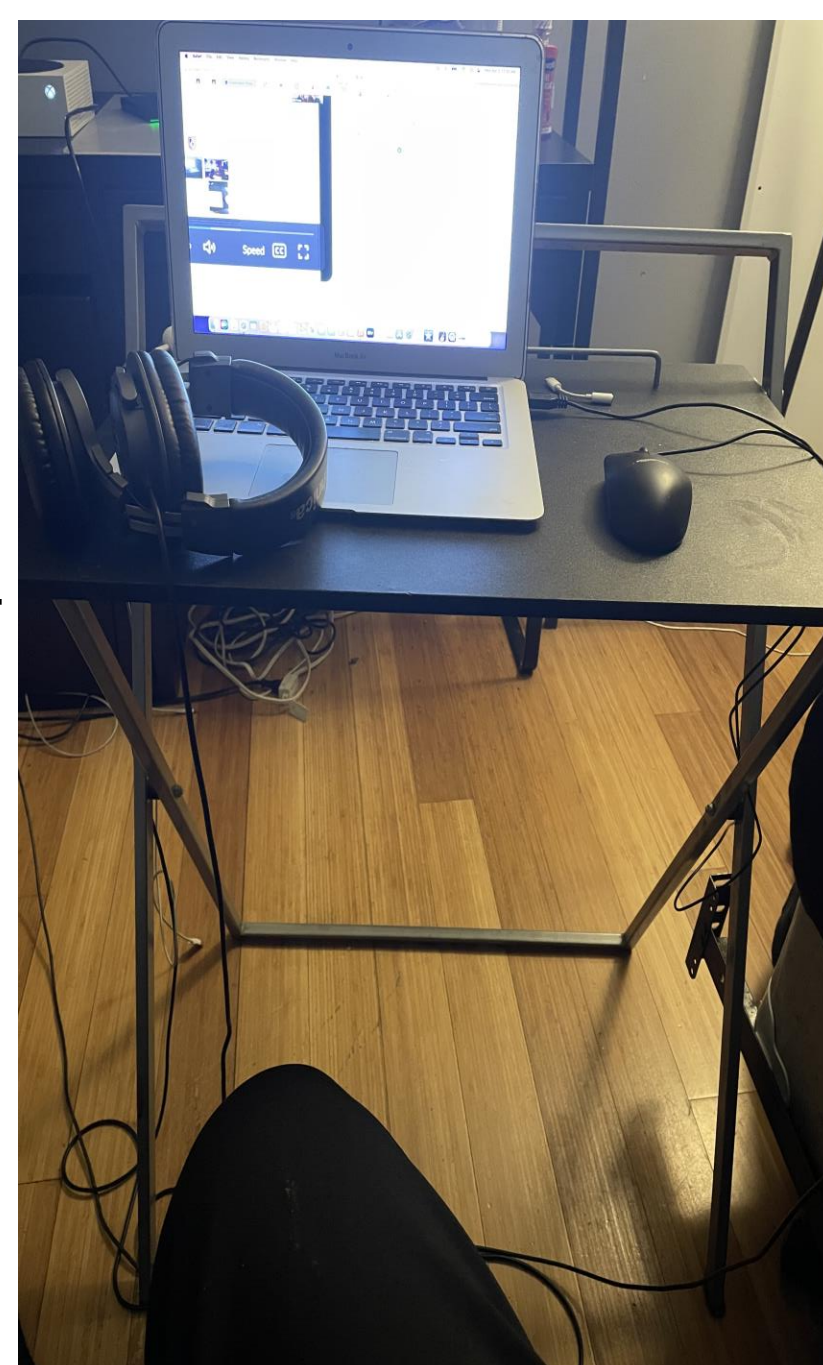




# Culmination Project: Pass By Kyle Holston

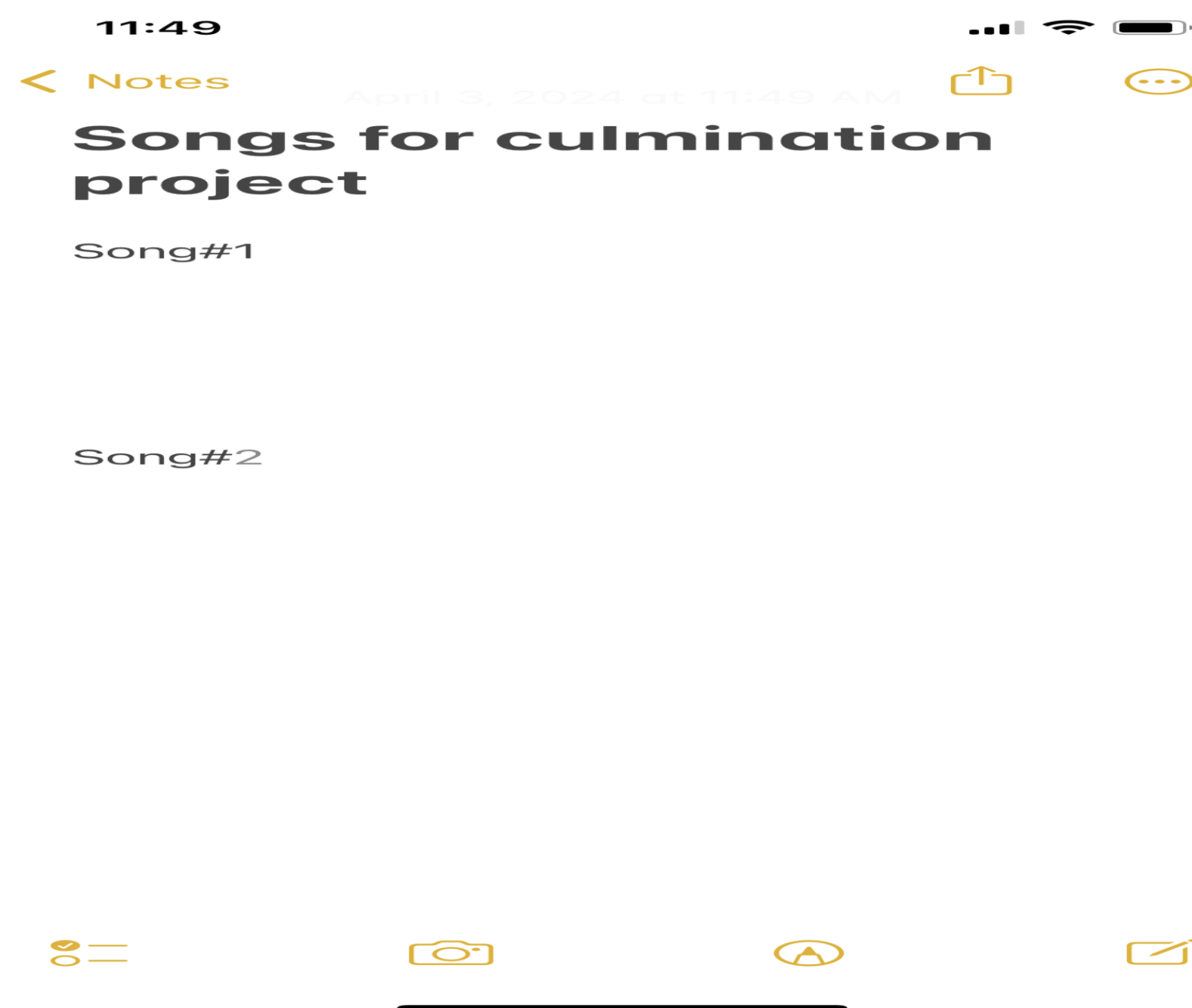
