- how many original forms of media - comic, literature, etc - eventually shifts and changes into ~~physical~~ digital media

- action figures were promoted w/ the first animated series (1987)
→ live action & films released in 1990s.

Peanuts - Woodstock, Snoopy, Charlie Brown

- Sunday American comic strip written and illustrated by Charles M. Schulz.

- most popular and influential in the history of comic strips (17,897 strips published in all).

- ran in over 2,600 newspapers, readership of around 355 million in 75 countries.
→ was first adapted into animation in the Tennessee Ernie Ford Show

* The Underground Mainstream *

- something to challenge the norms in media forms.

* The Medium is the Message *

"all media are extensions of some human faculty" → extend ideas/our reach
↳ relating to topic b/c media is an extension of the eye → translate visions and thoughts (entertainment) where the methods of digital or paper media can communicate with specific audiences.

* Typophoto *

visually presenting of what can be optically apprehended → digital media/films → TV
- a new world communication composed in type
↳ in a way relates to the idea of comics, which are written forms of entertainment
