Not a Banksy, this wont end up in an art gallery, or even sold for any large amounts of money. It's art made by a tagger to show off their skills and increase their reputation



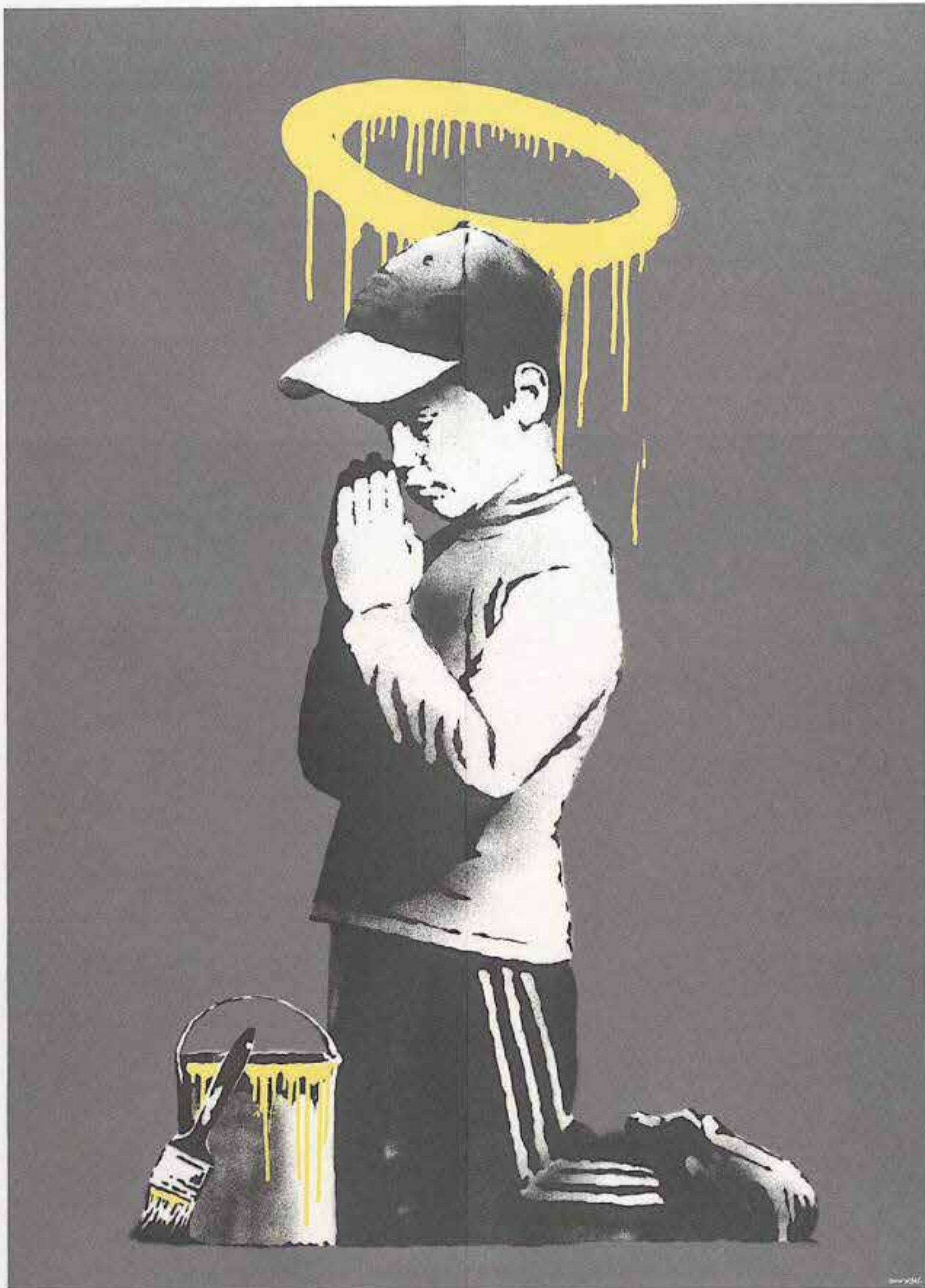


ONE NATION UNDER CCTV

GRAFFITI
