- Each written submission of a test or quiz must be in the form of a <u>multi-page PDF file</u> (if your work needed multiple pages) with your **school ID** on top of the first page.
- There will be NO MAKEUP tests. Any test you miss or do not submit will count as a 0 toward your final grade.
- Usage of any calculator app on an exam will result in an automatic 0 and a Faculty Action Report sent to you and the Academic Integrity Committee. Penalties that may be assessed include a 0 as an assessment grade or an automatic failure of the course.
- Students must pass the final exam with at least a score of 60 to pass this course. The student's class average before the Final exam may dictate that their passing score on the exam needs to be higher than a 60.
