

Quick Zine Definition, 1930's-Present

Self-published booklets sold cheaply or traded for others; gift economy

Noncommercial, nonprofessional, urgent, unmediated expression

Low tech materials (cheap paper, copy machine, staples)

DIY ethic: make your own culture and stop consuming that which is made for you*



DESCRIPTION

This self-published booklet is the first in a series of limited edition books dealing with photography in the age of Google image search. This one is homage to Ed Ruscha's 'Thirtyfour Parking Lots' originally published in 1967.

The original book contains 34 areal views of empty parking lots taken by areal photographer Art Alanis. The aerials were taken during a one-and-a-half-hour shoot on a Sunday morning, when the lots were empty resulting in a survey of the Los Angeles urban landscape of the late sixties.

Ruscha included a detailed address for all but one parking lot, the only text that accompanied the pictures, thus the book became a roadmap to revisit the original places, transforming the original book into a programmatic device for my project 'Thirtyfour Parking Lots on Google Earth'. The Riot Grrrl Collection is an attempt to document the evolution of the Riot Grrrl movement, particularly in the years between 1989 and 1996. Because Riot Grrrl was (and is) both a political and a cultural movement, its output was diverse, including writing, music, performance, film, activism, photography, video, and original art, as well as documentation of activism and performance. This research collection will provide primary resources for scholars who are interested in feminism, punk activism, queer theory, gender theory, DIY culture, and music history.







Alternative Publications (and similar analogue culture) sought after by “Cool Hunters” and “Taste Makers,” people who work in advertising, publishing, art (curators), fashion design, film making, and even politics.

Talented artists and writers often Do It Themselves (DIY), creating books, mags/zines, clothes, records and CD's, posters that may be found / "discovered" by people looking for new talent, trends, outlooks, and scenes that can be promoted (or exploited).
