First, read the letter alphabetically. Note that the same call number can be written from top-to-bottom, or 2010left-to-right. Then, read the number as a decimal: .65 (Some call number have more then one letter-number line) Milner Library uses Library of Congress Classification for call numbers. This system uses a combination of letters and numbers to arrange materials by subjects. The last line is the publication date, read it in chronological order: 1987, 1989, 2008, 2010 In the Catalog, you can also find location of an item and its availability. For maps showing the path to the different locations, look at the Find an Item in the Library tab
