

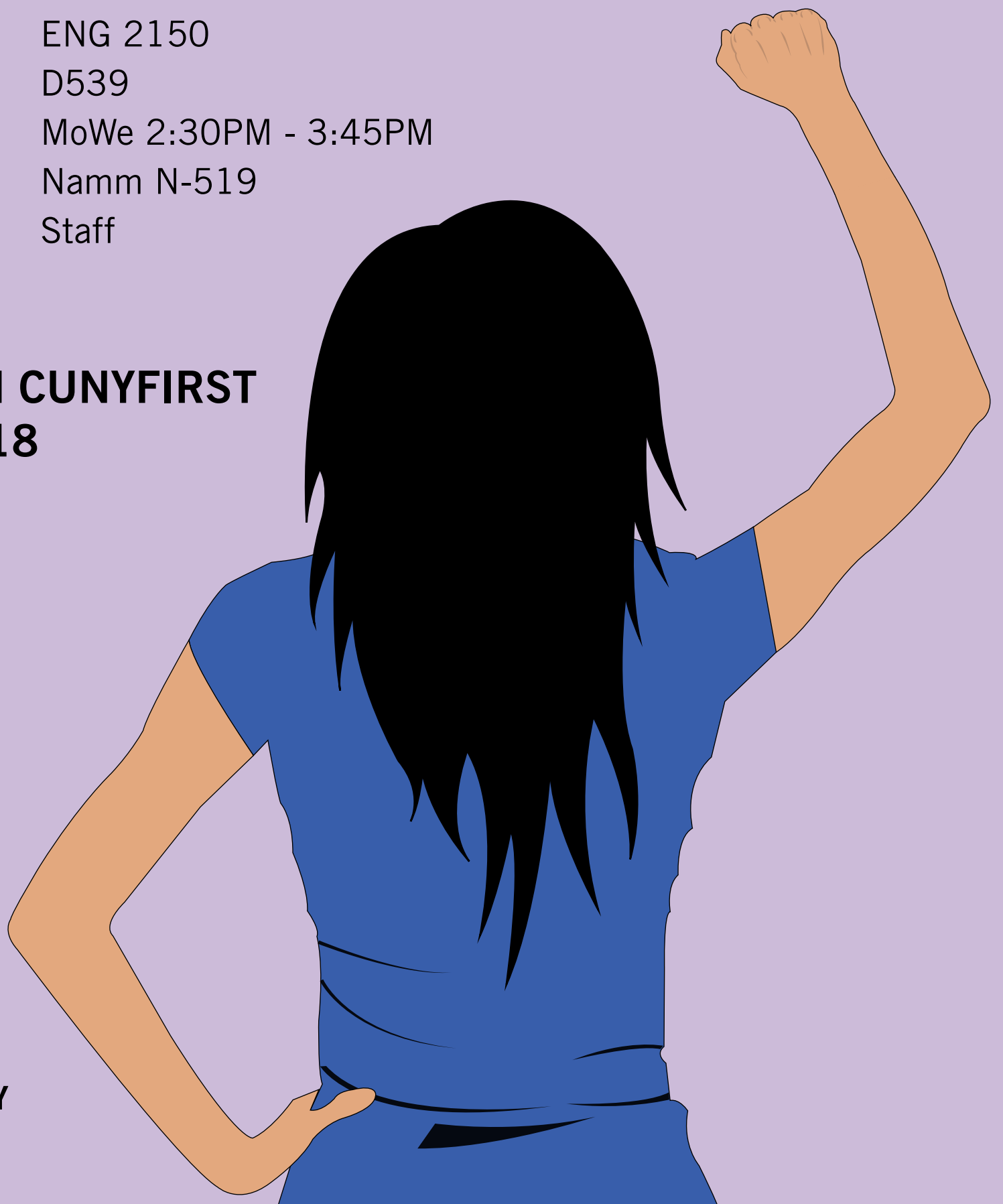
INTRODUCTION TO WOMEN WRITERS

Issues of form, structure and genre will be discussed. Students will read, analyze and discuss themes raised by women writers.
