How shows come together, how crews work, how important scheduling and pre-planning works, etc. Working at Gateway could be good for anyone as they hire people in lighting, carpentry, sound, stage management, costumes, props, and wig departments. If you are willing to work really hard and sometimes get very little sleep but learn so much and have a lot of fun (did I mention we had themed parties every other week and a company-wide water balloon fight in the dark??) then The Gateway Playhouse in Bellport, Long Island is definitely the place for you.
