Are parents the best decision makers for their own children?

- NO:
 - Sometimes they make very poor decisions
 - Usually the physician knows more about medicine than they do
 - Perhaps hospitals should have appointed pediatric decision makers to make all decisions for very young children

Should parents always have a right to make decisions for their children?
