When COVID-19 took hold of New York City, East Harlem Tutorial Program and It's East Harlem Scholars Academies redefined what learning would look like, and were among the first to prioritize safety and switch to remote classrooms. To date, we have distributed over 700 laptops and several hundred mobile hot spots to ensure our schools remain connected. Using several online learning programs, and one-to-one learning, we've been able to maintain an 88% attendance rate. We've also been supporting our larger EHTP community. Grab-and-go breakfast and lunch has been available at our 2050 Second Avenue location, and we recently partnered up with Butterbeans to drop meals throughout several locations in Harlem. Families can also leverage our Emergency Assistance Fund and apply for grants to cover the cost of rent, utilities, healthcare and more during this uncertain time.
