hi Zheng: We librarians like to use the phrase "due diligence." I hope you will take a few minutes to closely scrutinize the journal's website.

The *publisher* is well known and respected. I'd strongly suggest you read the journal to judge its quality and also review who is on the editorial board and who is managing editor. Do you know the names of these people?

The journal is a member of the Committee on Publication Ethics. Very important.

Glad to see that there are no article processing charges and that the fees are paid by the Communication University of China.

Abstracting and indexing is somewhat limited to only the Directory of Open Access Journals. This may affect the citation rate of your article which will be easily enough found on Google Scholar and Google but not elsewhere. It is good that the publisher uses DOIs.

Lastly, the journal does use Altmetrics which is helpful for your PARSE. This will give you some article-level metrics to document the impact of your work.

I doubt the journal has an impact factor. If they did, they would report it on their website.

These are the kinds of questions you'll want to ask of any journal. best, Monica
