I hope you are enjoying your spring semester. As you know, Harvard/COACHE is administering an online faculty survey on our behalf. As of today, our response rate for the ongoing COACHE administration is 54%. Thank you to those of you who have already completed the survey. For the 46% who have not yet had an opportunity, I hope you will consider taking the time to give your feedback. As mentioned by Provost August, City Tech will NOT be receiving the unit-level data from Harvard, so your identity is completely protected.

City Tech believes that its faculty are the foundation for the College's success. The results of the survey will be used to gauge faculty satisfaction and utilize the College resources in ways best attuned to the needs of the faculty.
