hi Michael: I'd stay away from them. You do not want to publish with a sketchy, unknown publisher. They may be predatory.

Notice that they are inviting you to publish on a short timeline in addition to joining their board.

No contact info for the editor (a generic email)

Is the publisher anyone you've ever heard of or read? No, right.

The publisher is chiefly in science, biomedical. That is not necessarily an important detail but telling.

The publisher is not part of the Open Access Scholarly Publishers Association or the Directory of Open Access Journals.

The journal is not indexed in any library databases

The fees for publishing with them are high https://medwinpublishers.com/processing-fee.php [notice that they did not offer to reduce or waive your fees if you review for them]
