hi David: Citation practices vary and think of a) when you need to give credit to someone's thinking and b) when you need to back up something you are asserting. I would keep those two factors in mind. Obviously, if you are quoting or paraphrasing, you must cite. If you have a target journal in mind, look at some articles and see how citation dense they are.

I would consider drafting a section first and then going back and plugging in your sources or just adding to the text the name of the thinker as a placeholder for a citation. We all write differently but I'm trying the technique I'm suggesting to you. best, Monica
