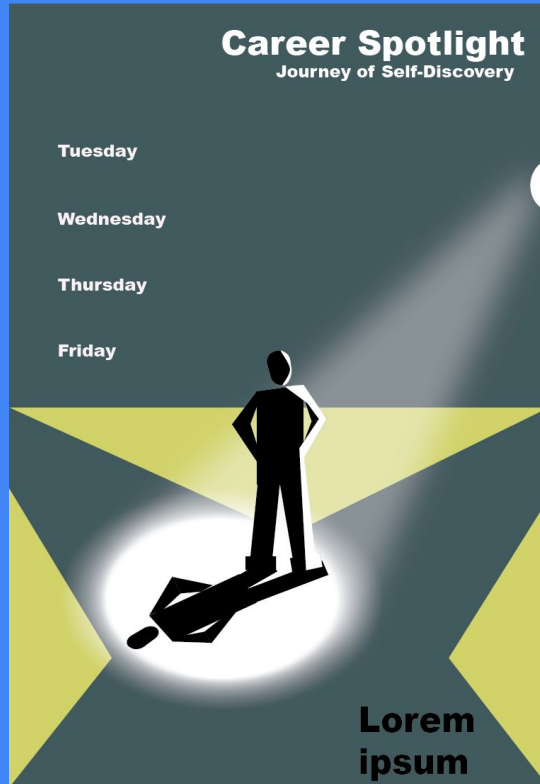

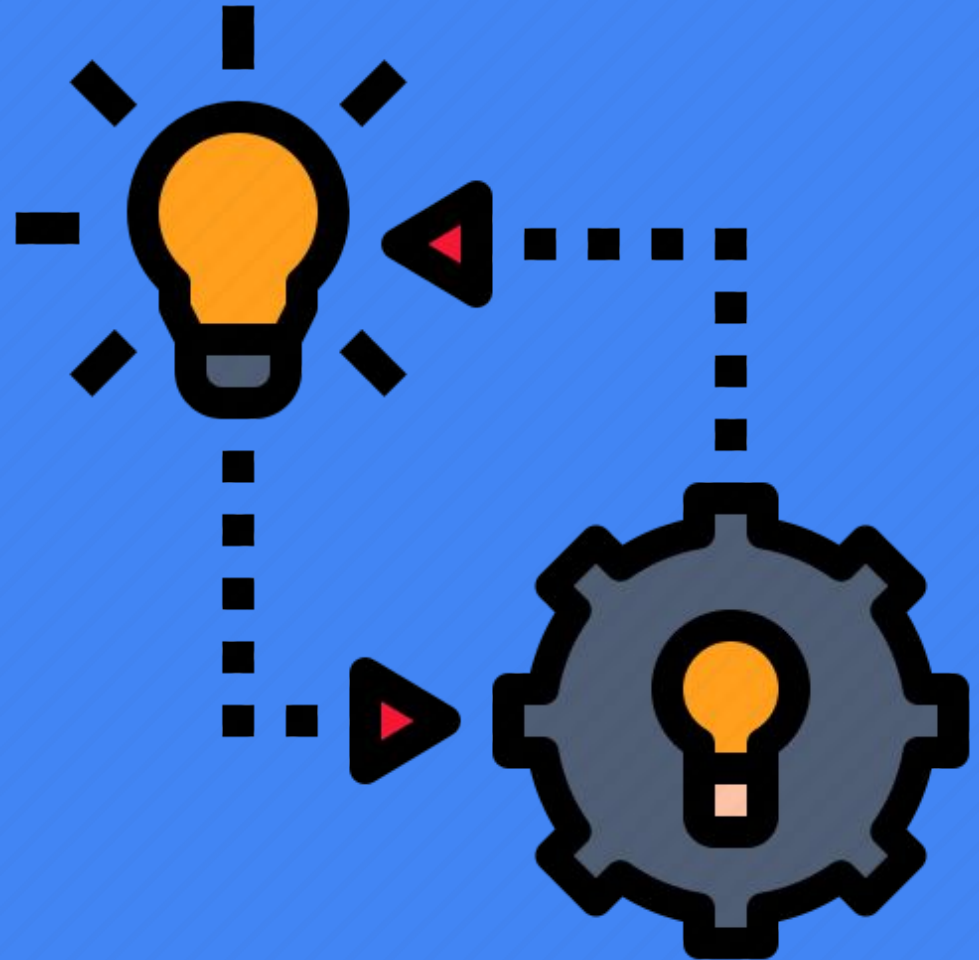
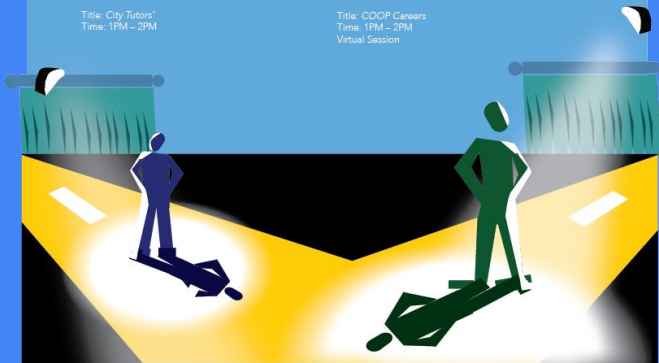

What is an Elevator Pitch?

An Elevator Pitch is essential for selling products, services, or financing from investors. It's a short, concise, and compelling pitch that you can deliver in a short amount of time, typically 30 seconds to 2 minutes. It's a key tool for entrepreneurs and business owners to quickly communicate their value proposition to potential investors, partners, or clients.

5 STEPS TO CREATING AN ELEVATOR PITCH

- 1 Identify yourself**
Start by introducing yourself and your company. Be clear and concise about who you are and what you do. For example, "I'm [Name], CEO of [Company], and we're a leading provider of [Service/Product]."
- 2 Describe your speciality**
Focus on the unique value of your product or service. Highlight what sets you apart from the competition. For example, "Our [Product/Service] is the only one that offers [Unique Feature/Benefit]."
