




SYNOPSIS:

Johnson took control of the fashion label "Alley Cat" which was popular with the rock 'n roll musicians of the day


1969 Opened a boutique called Opened a bounque on New Betsey Bunky Nini on New York City's Upper East Side.

"Johnson's clothes are commercial, which is to say they are less about appealing to magazine editors and celebrity stylists and more about attracting mass-market customers who do not want to spend a fortune on a dress. She loves crinolines, sequins, slip dresses and the color pink. Her clothes offer bad-girl attitude without the cleavage or the drug haze — and for less than \$200 a frock." (Givhan, 2015)

"The fashion industry is not that kind to people like Betsey" who ignore trends and cling to their own visions, says Kim Hastreiter, a co-founder of Paper magazine....."Her clothes were never really expensive; they were always really in the junior market. Her personality was probably not the kind of personality that high-fashion types could relate to." (Givhan, 2015)

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
