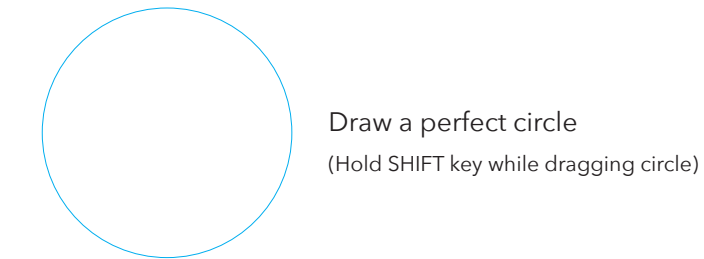

Type on a PATH

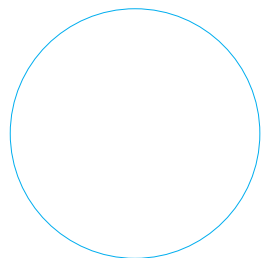
Ellipse



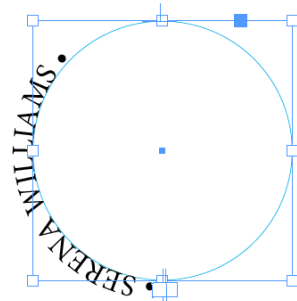
Top TEXT



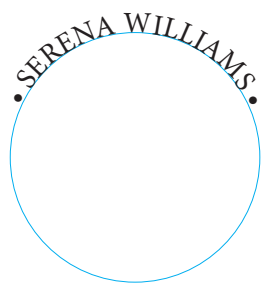
Draw a perfect circle
(Hold SHIFT key while dragging circle)



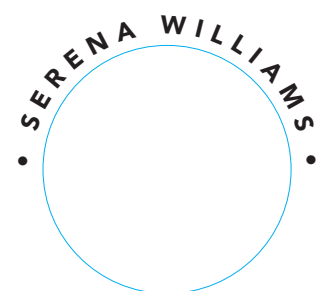
Select the Type on a PATH tool



Place cursor on middle/bottom point and type words

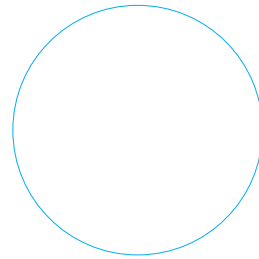


Highlight and center (alignment)

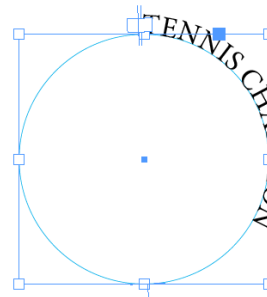


Select typeface/font/size/case
Control tracking and kerning

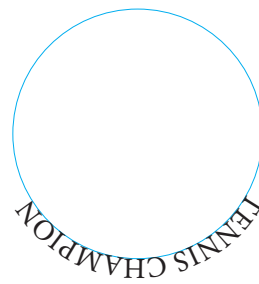
Bottom TEXT



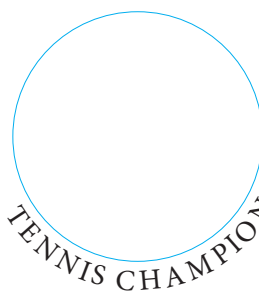
Draw a perfect circle



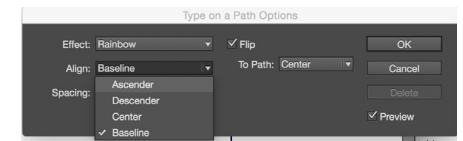
Select the Type on a PATH tool
Place cursor on middle/top point and type words



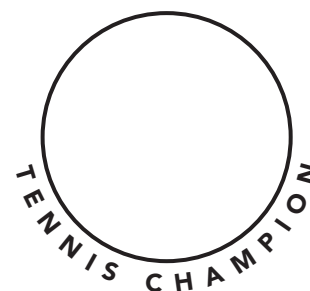
Highlight and center (alignment).
It will be upside down



GO to TYPE > Type on a PATH > OPTIONS



Check FLIP
ALIGN: Choose as needed

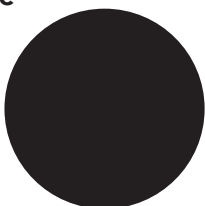


Add color and width to circle stroke



Select typeface/font/size/case
Control tracking and kerning

Inside circle



Draw circle and fill black
