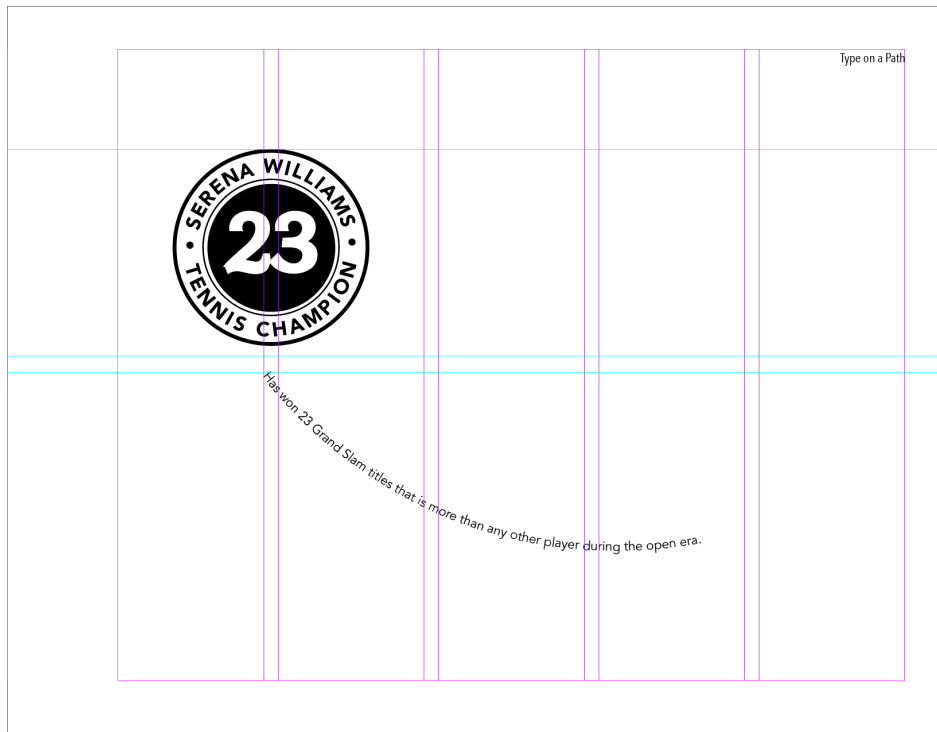


Graphic Assignment: Type on a Path



Use our regular grid, you can use the entire area of the 4 first columns as art area.

Column #5 for heading : Text on a Path

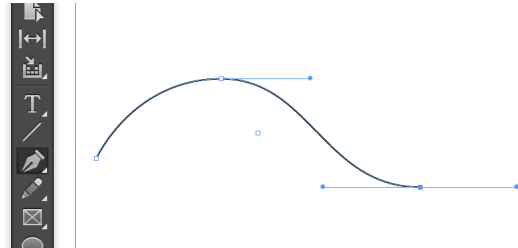
Use a sentence from your artist's bio (poem, song, etc) and place it on a smooth curve.

Pay attention to spacing issues (kerning), and adjust as necessary.

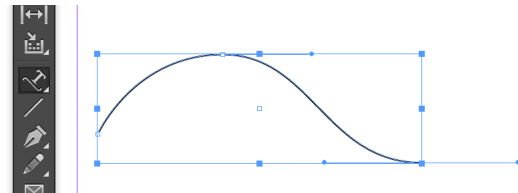
Use text related to your performer and create a mark using a circular path. See example above. Refer to *how to do a circular path* handout.

Type on a Path

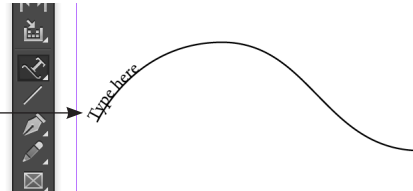
Draw a path with either the pen tool or the line tool



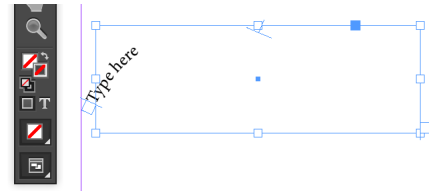
Switch the Type Tool to Type on a Path Tool



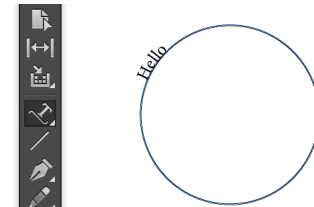
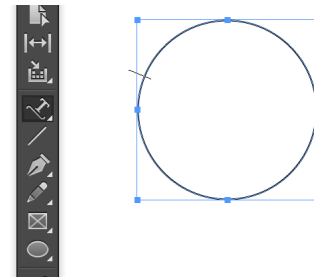
CLICK on the path, then type.



To remove the actual line, make sure that there is no color on it, or that the width of the stroke is at 0 (zero)



Follow the same principle for a specific shape like a circle, oval, square, etc. Draw the shape first, then use the Type on a Path tool
