Manhattan & the beginning of a

- New Amsterdam created by Dutch Settlers CA 1664
- 1st to settle on lower Manhattan
- Duke of York kicks them out
- Wall St. was named after the wall built in this area by the Dutch to keep Native Americans on the other side.
- Patterns created for land ownership
- Dutch is kicked out, British are now in power.
- Open spaces to relieve from density of the city
- Late 18th century ^{Brooklyn} is behind the development that's happening in Manhattan.
- 1780's Revolutionary War.
- 1797 people start to travel across to the United States.
- arriving at the New York Harbor.
- 1811 plan Green Spaces were Randomly placed.

- Central Park was NOT in the 1811 plan as a green space
- Central Park was born from high density of people living in an area to have a sort of relief
- fine Atlas maps Sanbourne Maps.
 - maps show how the city evolved
- Brooklyn doesn't get a grand master plan like Manhattan 1811
- 60s maps
- 1924 maps changed
- 1924 cars start to emerge
- 1951 more green spaces start to be made.
