Flag

The flag of Egypt is a tricolour consisting of the three equal horizontal red, white, and black bands of the Arab Liberation flag dating back to the Egyptian Revolution of 1952.



Religion

Egypt is predominantly Muslim, with Muslims accounting for an estimated 90% of the total population in 2017. Although without a government census the actual numbers cannot be known.



History

The Great Pyramid of Giza is the oldest and largest of the three pyramids in the Giza pyramid complex bordering what is now El Giza, Egypt. It is the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the only one to remain largely intact.

Hasheesh It is one of the country's main tourist centers and the second largest Egyptian city (after Suez) located on the Red Sea coast.




