

Challenges

- Due to having some bloody scenes in our film we had to have a plan B in case we did not get permission to film at the school. We looked and plan for other location in case.
- Planning and scheduling we had account for 6 people (including myself) to be free and be available the days we need to film. As this was everyone's first time acting it was challenging for our actors to act and remember there lines.
- For filming the blood scene we had many email discussion with our technical advisor about if it was even possibly. With the help of Prof. John McCullough he sent emails to the school and school safety about our film. We were able to shoot these scenes with the safety of everyone and supervision of the department's faculty.

- Used a paint brush to apply the blood on the knife and wall.
- Foam brush to apply on the clothes
- Had retractable knives to show stabbing.
- Clean up after our mess made sure we didn't stain any wall or floors.
 Used clorox wipes, paper towels and garbage bags to lay on the floor.

Things I learn and Conclusion

- This project was challenging from time management, planning and scheduling to learning a new camera, getting to know my equipment and being ready for anything.
- Relearning the basics of editing.
- Filming at any location you need permission. (Documentation)
- Encourage the actors and actress. Communication between the team and push our self to get this project done.
