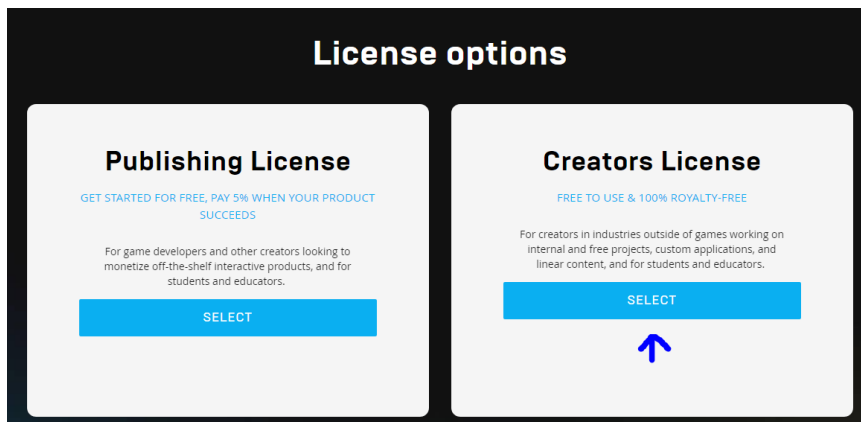


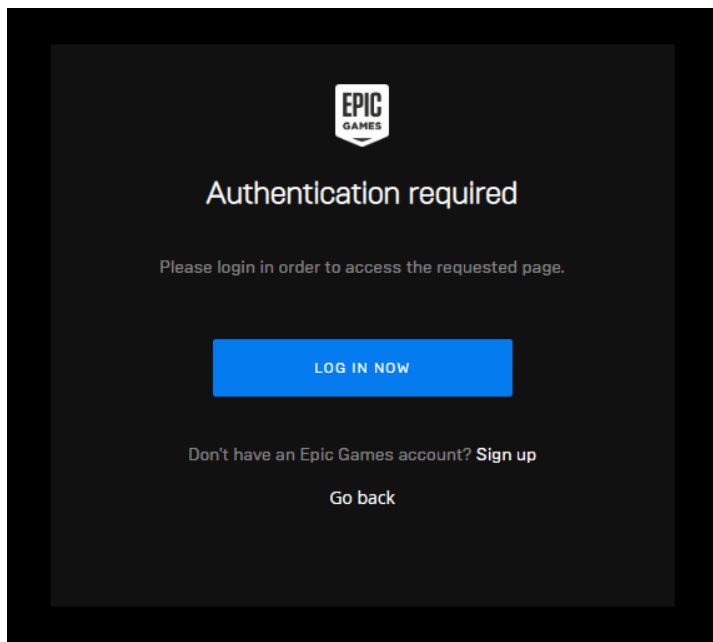
## MTEC Connect - Unreal Engine Set-Up Guide

The following is a guide to downloading and installing the Unreal Engine. In order to use the Unreal Engine you will have to install the Epic Games Launcher, but all that will be covered in the guide below..

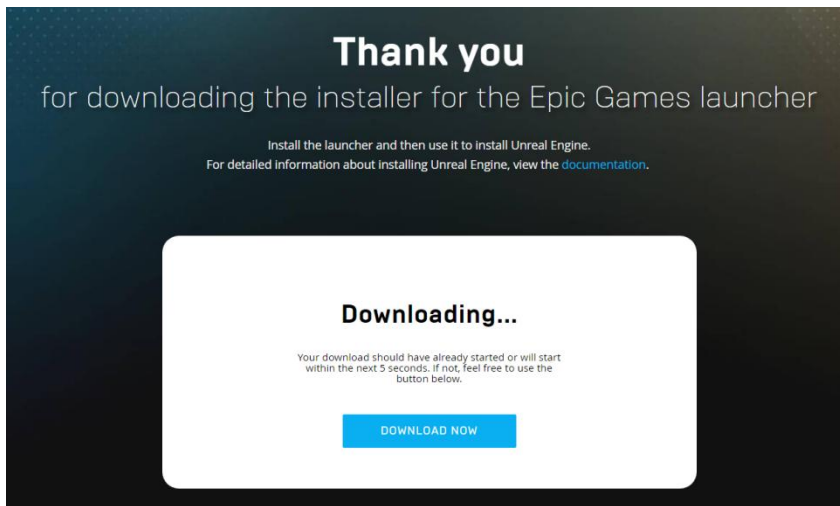
1. Head on over to <https://www.unrealengine.com/en-US/get-now> and you will be presented with two License options for download. Go ahead and select the Creators License.



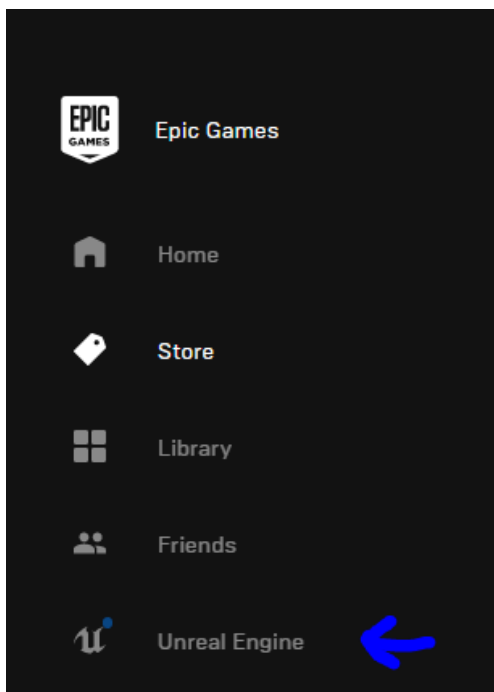
2. In order to install the Unreal Engine you have to login or sign up for a new account. If you have an account go ahead and login, otherwise click "Sign up" to create an account.



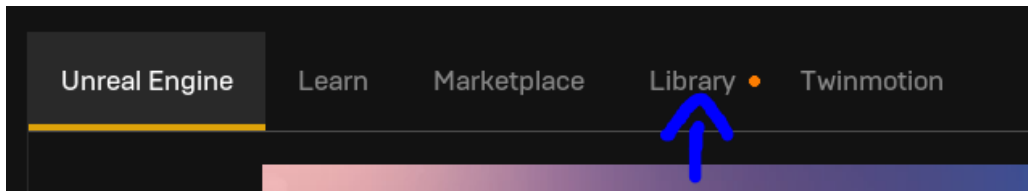
3. Once you've have an account, go ahead and login to the account. This will take you to the download page, which will automatically download the installer for you. If it's not downloading automatically then click the "Download Now" button instead.



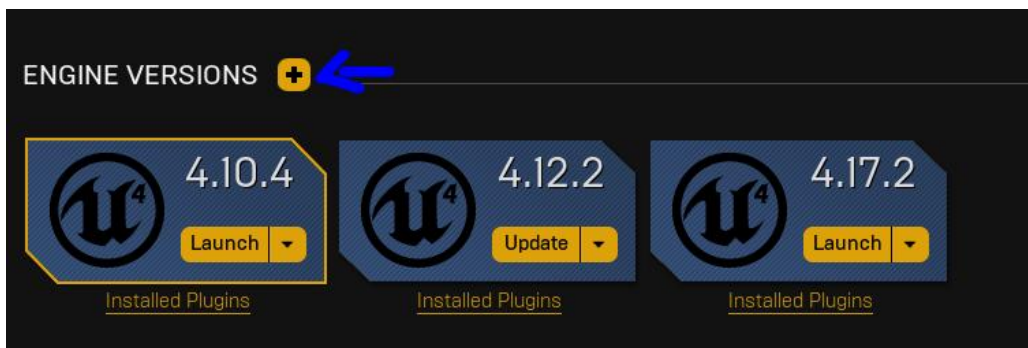
4. Go ahead and run the Epic Games installer. During the setup it will ask you to choose a folder where to install but you can leave it as is. With the launched installed, go ahead and launch it and login to the Epig Games Launcher.
5. Once logged in, on the left side, there is a section called "Unreal Engine", so go ahead and click on it.



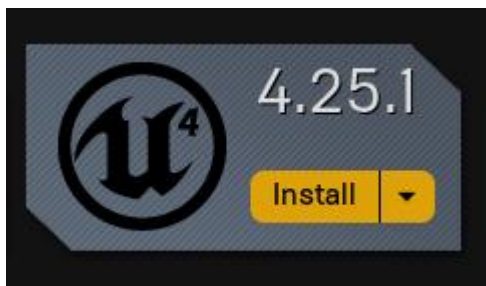
6. Along the top are several options, but you'll want to click "Library".



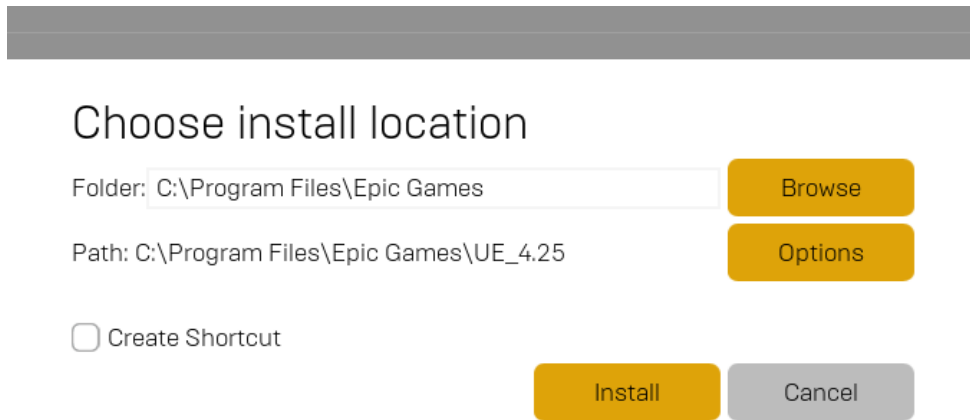
7. Here you will find various engine versions. Since I've used it before I have different versions installed, but you can go ahead and click the plus symbol to add a new version.



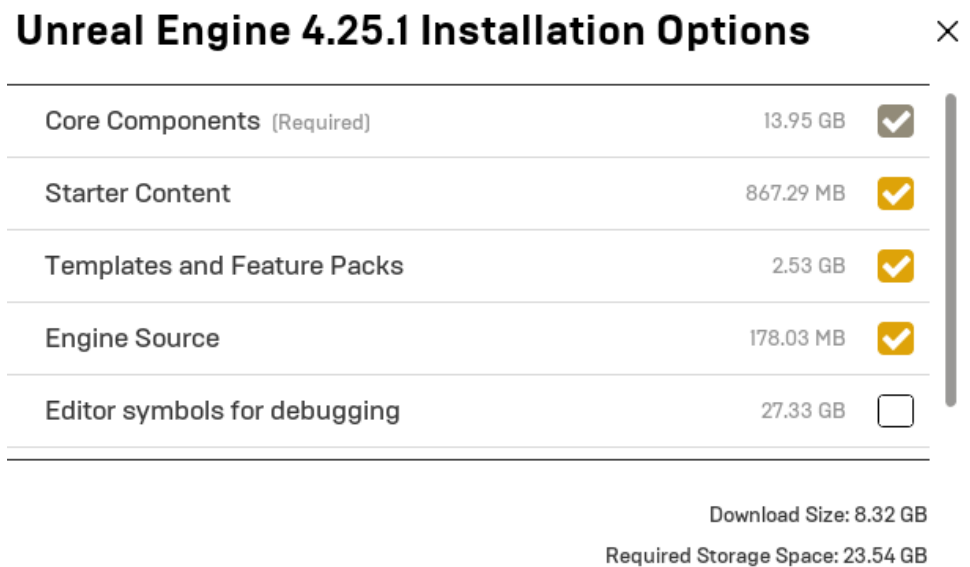
8. That will add an icon with a drop-down menu for versions. You can leave it on the latest version and click Install.



9. You're given options for whether you want to change the install location, but you can leave it as default.



10. There's also an "Options" button that lets you add or remove features from the installation. Clicking Options brings up several checkboxes; you can save some space by removing the iOS and Linux checkboxes under "Target Platforms", otherwise you can leave everything else as is. When you're ready click Apply and then Install.



11. Unreal will take the time to download and install, but once it's done you're all set with the Unreal Engine.
