## **ASSIGNMENT**

Consider the overall theme(s) of the text, as well as *specific examples* of how that theme is played out, and why it is important. Use the context to better understand the choices, reactions, and feelings of the main characters, as well as narrative choices made by the author. Your essay should have a clear thesis statement (including reasons), and make an argument about how to interpret the literary text.
