



What is F.I.R.S.T Robotics ?

A high school club that consists of 30 students and 10 mentors who work together to create a functioning robot starting the first Saturday of January. On that day, the game is revealed, which shows what this year's game consists of, how the game is played and what type of robot you need to create to play the game at its fullest potential. Each participating team is given 6 weeks to create and finalize their robot.

What competition is like?

After the 6 weeks, over 100+ competitions take place around the United States. This is the time when you take your robot that you've worked on the 6 weeks prior, to compete against another club's robot. The winners of the competitions get a spot to participate in the FIRST Robotics Championship at Detroit, Michigan where you play against other winning robots on the first week of May.

2. Great scholarships opportunities even including ivy league school to state public schools and from full rides to \$5,000 a year.

Personal Thoughts


