Death rate for Americans

- Over 1 million Americans have been shot in the past decade, and gun violence rates are rising across the country.
- Every year, 115,551 people are shot, 38,826 people die from gun violence, 14,062 are murdered,
- Gun is one way of ending own's life, nearly 50% of all suicides in America involve a gun and suicides account for about 60% of all gun-related deaths
- On an average at least 10 people get hurt or die from gun violence every day in the United States

Impact of gun violence in America

- On an average basis, people lose their life to gun violence, mass shootings or homicide. These deaths occur primarily based on one deadly weapon known as a gun, pistol or firearm.
- Social, emotional, and physical well-being and mental health needs of people who have been exposed to gun violence
- Guns are a devastatingly effective means of ending one's own life. Nearly
 50% of all suicides in America involve a gun and suicides account for about
 60% of all gun-related deaths

Prevention for Gun Violence

- 1. Create programs to educate the community about ways to prevent gun violence. Recognize gun violence as a critical and preventable public health problem.
- Implement Universal Background Checks for anyone who wants to own a firearm
- 3. Require Child Safety Features for Every Gun or invest in smart guns that only work on special passcodes or face ID.
- 4. Look out for warning sign in potential shooters or criminals.
- 5. Invest in communities to promote resilience and mental health and wellbeing.
- 6. Fund more Prevention programs and implement them in schools, shelters, and other public areas
