Since the mid-20th Century, gang violence in this country has become widespread. All 50 states and the District of Columbia have reported gang problems. This issue severely ruins the lives of youth, who predominantly join gangs. Data from the National Gang Center surveys found that during the mid-1990s to the early 2000s there was a decline in gang problems. However, the prevalence of gang activity greatly climbed between 2001 and 2005 and has since remained constant.

One of the most well-known events involving gang violence occurred in the Bronx when Guzman-Feliz also is known as Junior fell victim to gang violence. Members of the offending gang were aged 18 to 24 and had mistaken the young boy for someone else. Junior was stabbed multiple times in the street with machetes and knives. This gang the Trinitarios were also found to be responsible for two other murders. Almost every year there are accidents related to gangs.
