Dr. Zhang is an active member serving as manuscript reviewer, panel and workshop organizer. She also frequently served as a panelist to review proposals at National Science Foundation. Dr. Zhang holds a Ph.D. and an M.S. in Information and library studies from the University of Michigan and an M.S. and B.S. in cognitive psychology from Peking University in Beijing China.
