



**CSTEP (Collegiate Science and Technology Entry Program)** is a student success initiative funded by the New York State Education Department. CSTEP is designed to support students in majors needed in the NYS workforce including **STEM fields: science, technology, engineering, math** and the licensed professions such as **Nursing, dental health, architecture, engineering technologies**. CSTEP provides academic support to underrepresented students in eligible majors to facilitate college and career success.

**CSTEP offers:**

- **Cash Stipends of up to \$600 per semester for the completion of the program requirements.**
- **Free** Online & In-Person Tutoring
- **Early Registration** Opportunity
- **Internships & Research** Opportunity
- **Free** Standardized & Certification test preparation
- **Up to \$500 reimbursement** for acquiring field Certifications before graduating
- Personalized academic **advisement and Mentoring**

**CSTEP Program Eligibility:** Based on NYSED mandated criteria, eligible applicants will:

- **New York state** resident
- **MUST** be Enrolled **full time (12 credits or more)** each semester at City Tech
- **NOT** Enrolled **SEEK, ASAP, or ACE** program
- Major in **STEM** or a career leading towards a licensed profession (see below the listed major)
- Student must be one of the following: **African-American, Hispanic/Latino, American Indian or Alaskan native OR economically disadvantaged** (under the **TAP** or/and **PELL** grants or meet the **New York State Opportunity Programs Income Eligibility Criteria** in the back.

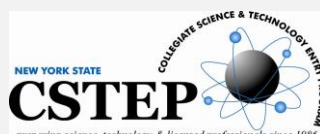
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**CSTEP Program Requirements**

- ✓ **Tutoring:** CSTEP students with a **GPA below 2.5 MUST attend mandatory tutoring** sessions or other academic supports.
