

## ASCE LONG ISLAND BRANCH YOUNGER MEMBER COMMITTEE 2023 STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The American Society of Civil Engineers represents more than 150,000 members of the civil engineering profession in 177 countries. Founded in 1852, ASCE is the nation's oldest engineering society. In North America alone, there are 76 Sections, 160 Branches, 105 Younger Member Groups, and 302 Student Chapters.

Engineering pushes the limits of innovation through imaginative means. Civil engineering is a profession that can directly influence the public in a number of beneficial ways. Whether that be through transportation development, construction, structural design, water resources, etc., civil engineers provide for a more functional society. The 2023 scholarship application essay prompt topic is as follows:

## "How does the work of civil engineers impact the health of the public and how could you envision contributing to that function?"

## Scholarship application rules:

- 1. Two \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded. One scholarship recipient will be selected in each of the following categories:
  - a. A senior currently attending high school in Queens, Brooklyn, or on Long Island, and planning to attend college for engineering.
  - b. A student currently enrolled at a college or university in Queens, Brooklyn, or on Long Island and majoring in engineering.
- 2. Award of scholarships will be made at the sole discretion of the ASCE Long Island Branch (LIB).
- 3. Scholarship recipients will be notified of award in May 2023. Recipients will be honored at the annual ASCE LIB Awards Ceremony on June 1, 2023.
- 4. Scholarship essays are to be between 750 and 1,000 words, double-spaced, and answer the essay prompt above.
- 5. The essay can only be written by one person and cannot have previously been used or published in any other essay competition or publication.
- 6. Please include the following in the body of the document:
  - a. Candidate name
  - b. Candidate e-mail address
  - c. Candidate phone number
  - d. Candidate grade level in Fall 2023
  - e. Candidate's intended or current college in Fall 2023
