To be eligible for a scholarship, students must:

- ✓ Be U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien,
- ✓ Be enrolled full time (at least 12 credits per semester) in the BS program in Applied Mathematics or Biomedical Informatics, or the AS program in Chemical Technology or Computer Science,
- ✓ Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form and demonstrate financial need,
- ✓ Demonstrate academic potential:
  - For current students, a cumulative GPA at least 3.0;
  - For entering transfer students with an associate degree, a GPA of at least 3.2.
  - For entering freshmen: 85% high school average and 12
    CPI credits, including at least two Science and three English credits.
  - Meet eligibility for pre-calculus or higher math.
