Transparency Effect: Opacity for a color image in InDesign

* Note: here are multiple ways of achieving this effect.

Go to InDesign and place the image



Go to WINDOWS> EFFECT and change **Opacity**

Contracts > Effects > E





Image will stay in color, but appears lighter
