



For your first round of thumbnails, use just your own messy handwriting. This way you can focus more on the basic idea of the layout before you add any details.


HIERARCHY & THUMBNAILS

These studies are just quick ways to try out different styles, so create various options using just one letter vs. drawing entire words to save on time.

TYPE STUDIES

Now that you've selected a layout, you can try out different ways of styling and adding decorations to your letters. Victorian lettering is known for those tiny ornate details, so be sure to add elements like dots, filigree, and drop shadows for that wow factor.





For a steadier hand, always draw lines going towards you while inking. When drawing long, straight lines, lock your wrist and move only your arm.

REDRAW & REFINE

For easier placement, redraw your concept by first drawing the containers of your letters and then draw the skeleton of each word inside them. Only then should you begin to add weight and style to your piece. Then, refine your work and carefully ink your final sketch drawing.
