## **Assignment: Presenting Course Work on Your ePortfolio**

#### Your Goal

Post your (3) best works completed in this course and write a personal reflection about the work on a new page in the "Academics" section of your ePortfolio.

#### Step 1: Create an Account

(If you already have an OpenLab Account proceed to Step 2.)

- 1. **CITY TECH EMAIL**: To create an account on the OpenLab you will need to access your City Tech email account. Contact the Help Desk at 718-260-4900 or visit the Welcome Center on the first floor of the Atrium Building to learn how to access your City Tech email.
- 2. **REGISTER**: Visit openlab.citytech.cuny.edu. Click on the **Sign Up** link in the red box on the upper left side of the home page. Follow the instructions or click on OpenLab Help > "Setting up an Account" for step-by-step instructions.



- 4. **HELP:** If you have other problems signing up (not related to City Tech email) contact: <u>openlab@citytech.cuny.edu</u>.

#### Step 2: Create an OpenLab ePortfolio

(If you already have an OpenLab ePortfolio proceed to Step 3.)

- 1. **LOG IN:** Visit <u>openlab.citytech.cuny.edu</u>. Log in to OpenLab by entering your username and password in the gray box.
- 2. **MY OPENLAB**: Navigate to My OpenLab in the main site navigation.
- 3. **CREATE EPORTFOLIO**: Click on the text in the sidebar "Create an ePortfolio" and follow the creation process or click on OpenLab Help > Student ePortfolios > Creating an ePortfolio for step-by-step instructions.

#### Step 3: Create a New Page

(For help with this step, go to OpenLab Help > Building your Site)

- 1. MY OPENLAB: Navigate to My OpenLab in the main site navigation.
- 2. DASHBOARD: In the My OpenLab sidebar, click on the link "Dashboard" located below your ePortfolio link.
- 3. **NEW PAGE**: In the Dashboard navigation, click on Pages > "Add New"
- 4. **PARENT PAGE**: Locate the right-hand menu Page Attributes "Parent" and from the pull-down menu choose "Academics."
  - Note: If you don't have a parent page named "Academics," contact openlab@citytech.cuny.edu or stop by G606 for guidance.
- 5. **TITLE**: In the Title area, type the name of your course or the course code.
  - Example: Graphic Design Principles 1 or ADV1100
- 6. ADD MEDIA: Click on the "Add Media" button. Upload (3) quality, web-ready files of your best work from this course. Add a Caption to each image identifying the project title and semester/year.
  - Note: If you need help creating and saving web-ready files, contact openlab@citytech.cuny.edu or stop by G606 for guidance.
- 7. WRITE A REFLECTION: In the content area, write a 2-paragraph personal reflection about the work you are presenting. Identify your successes and your challenges.
- 8. **DOUBLE CHECK**: Review Step 3 guidelines.
- 9. SAVE OR PUBLISH: If you have followed the above instructions successfully, click "Publish." If you have questions or need to rework your page, click "Save Draft" and return later to publish your page.
  - Note: Your work will not be visible to your professor unless you click "Publish" and you have set your site settings to Public or Private > visible to City Tech members, or have invited your professor to "Join" your ePortfolio.
