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## Project #2: Squares and Graphic Expression

Using four black squares **all the same size**, create a graphic image to express the meaning of each of the following 6 words:

order increase bold congested tension playful

For each word:

- Prepare by cutting squares in groups of 4 or more. Cut groups of 3/8", 1/2", 3/4", 1", squares; you may need bigger ones (1 1/4" or 1 1/8" for determining the final design)

- Map the groupings in each square on the handout sheet. You must have 6 ideas per word.

- Lay a tracing paper on top (9 x 12) and trace all 6 ideas for the **one word** onto the tracing paper. Be sure to include the one word you are working with (circle it and trace it).

- Use only 4 squares of the same size per frame.

- For the final work, you may have a different size **set** of *4 squares* in each frame.


For **each** of the words you will have:

6 variations for one word on tracing paper.

You will be selecting and completing the best one to finalize the project on a larger square. (See Page 2)

Note: use triangles and rulers. Must be well measured, and neatly executed. It will count!
