

WordPress vs Muse

WordPress is a free and open source blogging tool and content management system based on PHP and MySQL. WordPress has many features including a plug-in architecture and a template system. WordPress is currently the most CMS in use on the Internet. WordPress was released on May 27, 2003 by Matt Mullenweng as a fork of b3/cafelog. By the December 2011 the version 3.0 had been downloaded over 65 million times. B2/cafelog was estimated to approximately employed 2,000 blogs on of the year 2003.

WordPress users may install and switch between themes. The themes in WordPress allows the users to change the look and functionality of a website or installation without altering the information content. Some of the features that could help you download a theme is by using the WordPress "Dashboard" administration tool, or you could upload it theme folders via FTP. WordPress also use Widgets, widgets are small modules that offer users drag and drop sidebar content placement and implementation of many plugins extended abilities. The widgets offer WordPress developers to add functionality to their site. Some of the functions that small widgets can be used for are facebook like box, a slide show and news slider. WordPress also supports the Trackback and Pingback standards for displaying links to other links that have themselves links to blogs or an article

Adobe muse makes life easier for designers that you use InDesign, Illustrator, and Photoshop. The main purpose of this program muse is that designers don't

code like HTML, CSS, or Javascript to break through the barrier of designing for the Internet. What muse could be use is for wedding website or for a small business page, because they don't have to change information that often and it doesn't have to be updated. Muse was created as powerful tool for a professional creative who need to reach the web but don't have the time or patience to learn how to code.

Adobe Muse is use for a page layout tool and for a website design based on a Master Page concept similar to that in Adobe InDesign. Muse removes a lot of the web specific complexity that previously stood in the way of creative's who wanted to get attractive layouts and design on the web, but found Dreamweaver. The only thing that is missing from the Muse is a website template. Muse will be in free beta until it is officially released in the early 2012.
