- Council of Fashion Designers of America (CFDA) *Special Award*, 1981

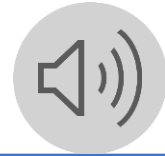

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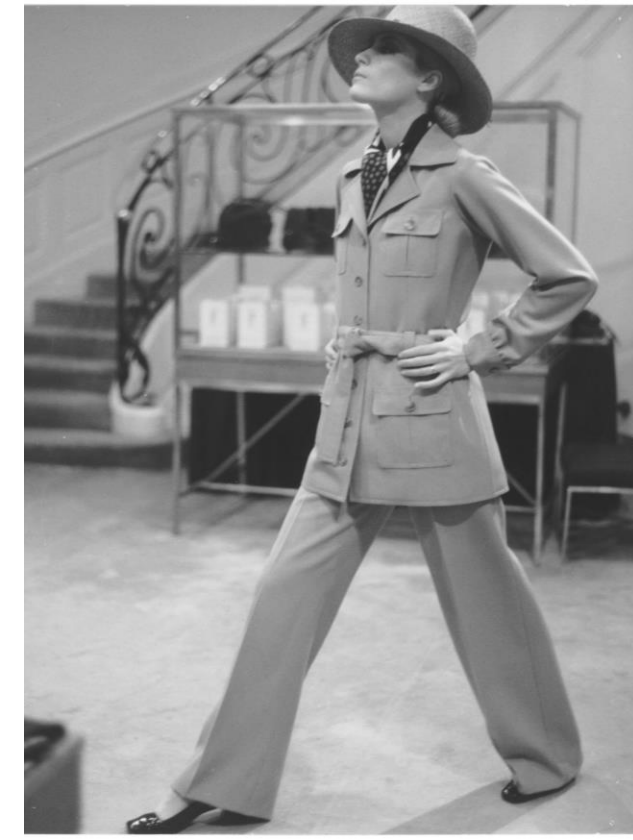




Career



- **At 17:** Left Algeria to study art in Paris
- **1954:** Shared first prize with Karl Lagerfeld in an International Wool Secretariat design competition
- **1955:** Hired by Christian Dior as a design assistant
- **1957:** Dior died and Saint Laurent took over as head designer
- **1960:** Military
- **1961:** Opened his own couture house
- **1962:** First collection
- **1983:** The Costume Institute of the Metropolitan Museum of Art dedicated a 25-year exhibition of his work
- **1993:** YSL sold for \$650 million. Tom Ford became creative director
- **2010:** Documentary
- **2012:** Heidi Slimane became creative director. She changed the brand name to Saint Laurent

Full name: Yves Henri Donat Matthieu Saint Laurent

He was bullied for looking like he was a homosexual. This led him to become a nervous child which caused him to be sick almost every-day
