This is an offer for extra credit for Test 1.

Do not write anything or change anything on the original test paper. If you do, you will invalidate this extra credit.

On separate paper:

For each problem which did not receive full credit on Test 2:

- First, state what you did wrong (everything that was wrong!) If you did not do the problem at all, you have nothing to say. Otherwise, you must state what was wrong. You are being graded on this. Note: anything that is circled contains errors, but I did not necessarily circle every error.
- Next, redo the problem showing all your work or explaining your reasoning, and indicate your final answer clearly.
- Hand this in along with the original test paper.

You may receive up to half the missing points as extra credit, depending how fully and correctly you describe your errors and how correctly you redo the problems.

(This extra credit applies only to this test and cannot be carried over if this test score gets dropped at the end.)
